These youth suddenly become military kids even though they still look the same to teachers, friends, and the rest of the community. Their lives are turned upside down. They become the "Hidden Heroes".

The Hidden Heroes training being offered in your community is designed to give you a feel for our program, and a better understanding of the unique stressors that military youth and their families face before, during and after a deployment.
